Sub:- Higher Education Department - Pensionary benefits to Private College Teachers-Recovery of irregular payments- reg.

Ref:- 1. Letter No. 34750/F3/09/HEdn dated 14/12/2009.

2. Your letter No. M1/1779/2010/Coll.Edn dated 14/5/2012.

As per the Government letter cited you were requested to review all cases of irregular payment of pension sanctioned to the private college teachers reckoning their service prior to entering into the Direct Payment Scheme. On detailed examination at government level it was found that the proposal to recover the amounts already paid to teachers on account of payment reckoning the service prior to the Direct Payment Agreement with Private Colleges is impractical, as the number of teachers who were in service prior to 1972 is meagre and the administrative work involved in the recovery would not commensurate with the amount recovered. Hence taking a sympathetic stand Government decided to withdraw the directions contained in the letter cited ordering recovery.

You are requested to take further action to dispose off the pending cases immediately.
