ORDER

In the Government Order read as 1st paper above orders were issued reckoning the actual period of service in Government/Aided Schools put in by those Private College Teachers who have opted for Chapter III of the Pension Statutes, 1976 as qualifying service for Pension . **The Accountant General (A&E), Kerala in his letter read as 3rd paper above has pointed out that the**

conditions laid down under Rule 14E, Part III, Kerala Service Rules are to be insisted for the purpose of counting Aided School Service of Chapter III opted Private College Teachers prior to Private College Service.

2. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to order that the following conditions will be insisted for reckoning the Aided School Service of Private College Teachers who have opted Chapter III of the Pension Statutes, 1976 as qualifying service for pension.

- (i) That Manager's/Government's Share of Contributory Provident Fund, if any, should be refunded to Government and a Certificate to that effect should be furnished;
- (ii) That the School should be aided;
- (iii) That a Certificate that the service has been verified with reference to the Attendance Registers, Acquittance Rolls etc; and is qualifying for pension. The Service Verification Certificate should be Countersigned by the Deputy Director of Education and by the Pension Sanctioning Authority.
